

7. Leave Details

B.Sc. Nursing; There will be 8 weeks vacation in an academic year (Winter Vacation-2 Weeks, summer vacation - 6 weeks.) **Diploma in G.N.M.:** There will be 4 weeks vacation in an academic year. Students should produce their leave details to principal & parantel hospital administrator (**Dr. Rashmi Kanaujia, Sheela Hospital & Truma Centre & Dr. Shubha Dixit, Shekhar Hospital**) during clinical posting. Additional Leaves will have to be compensated. The students will be subjected to disciplinary action in case of unauthorized absenteeism

All students must have 80% attendance in all subjects separately & conduct are not satisfactory will not be allowed to appear in the examination.

8. During the traing period no students shall move any property of institution to their rooms (or) out side institute premises without the permission of concern authorities.

Hostel Rules and Regulation for the Students

- Visiting hrs are from 10AM to 4PM on sundays unless permission for other times
 is given by the warden. Only those relatives and friends can meet who are allowed
 in writing by the parents. No provision is made for housing of the relatives, but
 the students may obtain permission to go out with their families for meals or trip
 to the Market. She should return back to hostel positively by 6PM.
- 2. Student may go to the Market on Sundays. They have to take permission and return before 6PM.
- 3. All are not allowed to use Mobile in Hostel except 6 Pm to 8 pm.
- 4. The students should not keep any value things like jewellery and money more than Rs.300 in their rooms. The institution will not be responsible for any losses.
- 5. Each students is required to keep her room and surrounding clean and tidy.
- 6. The students should come for meals on time in the mess except the sicks. Food should not be taken to the rooms. The students are expected to stay in good manner to make the atmosphere of the dining room pleasant.
- 7. The students are not allowed to keep unwanted items like harmful drugs.
- 8. The principal will visit the hostel at anytime. Any irregularities, indiscipline is to be brought to the notice of the Principal. The principal in consultation with the management shall deal with any serious offence.

ADMISSION CRITERIA



Term & Condition

Age

Age for entrance shall be 17 Years to 35 Years as on 31 Dec. of the joining year.

Minimum qualification

All students should have passed XII class or its equivalents with science group (PCB) with an aggregate of 40% and 45% for GNM and B.Sc Nursing respectively. For Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing the candidate should be a registered GNM nurse.

Sex

Both Female and male candidates are eligible for admission, preference will be given to unmarried female candidates but married or divorcees can also apply.

Mental and physical status

Students should be physically & mentally fit.

General Information

- 1. Admission will be on the basis of entrance examination & personal interview.
- 2. The selected candidates shall pay a fee of Rs. 25000 in advance after declaring the result of the entrance examination.
- 3. Second Installment will be deposited on or before 1st of september. Remaining fees to be paid by December of that year.
- 4. The academic session will start from 1st September of each year.
- 5. During the training period the candidates are not supposed to do any other course.

Procedure for application

Prospectus & application forms for admission may be obtained by post or in person from the office of principal, on payment of Rs. 500/ by-D.D. or pay order payable at Shahjahanpur, or getting the form by post D.D. should be of Rs. 550/- All Payment must be made by Demand Draft in favour of Florence Nightingale College of Nursing, Shahjahanpur (U.P.)-242001.

Duly filled application form along with the following photo copies of documents should be submitted to the office of the principal prior to the closing date of (15 August) submitting the application form.

- 1. Attested copy of mark sheet of intermediate or equivalent examination.
- Attested copy of matriculation / equivalent examination certificate confirming the date of birth of the candidates.
- 3. Candidates belonging to S.C./S.T./O.B.C. should submit original certificate issued by the District magistrate / competent authority.
- 5. Conduct certificate from the principal / Head of college / institution last attended.
- 6. In case of N.R.I. candidates, nationality certificates is required.
- 7. Transfer / Migration certificate from the school / College last attended.
- 8. 4 passport size latest coloured photograph.
- 9. Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing students should submit attested copies of their GNM marks sheets, diploma certificate and registration certificate along with the copy of identity card.
